Planted in 1991, this was an early Sonoma Coast vineyard. Now owned by Jamshid & Mehri Fallahi, it was further developed with the advice of local winemaker Tony Austin and vinophile John Drady of Sonoma Coast Vineyards. Tucked in the literal gap of Petaluma Gap, along Antonio Creek that is the border between Marin and Sonoma Counties. This vineyard sells 90% of its fruit to wineries including Sonoma Coast, Berryessa Gap, and Schramsburg.

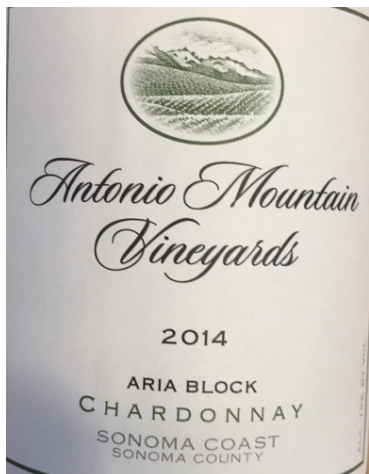

Aromas entice the appetite - flowers, fruit and white peach. On taste, a complex palate combines a touch of spicy vanilla with late summer notes of melon and fall sweet baking spice. Never over oaked, the gem sparkles with crisp minerality
